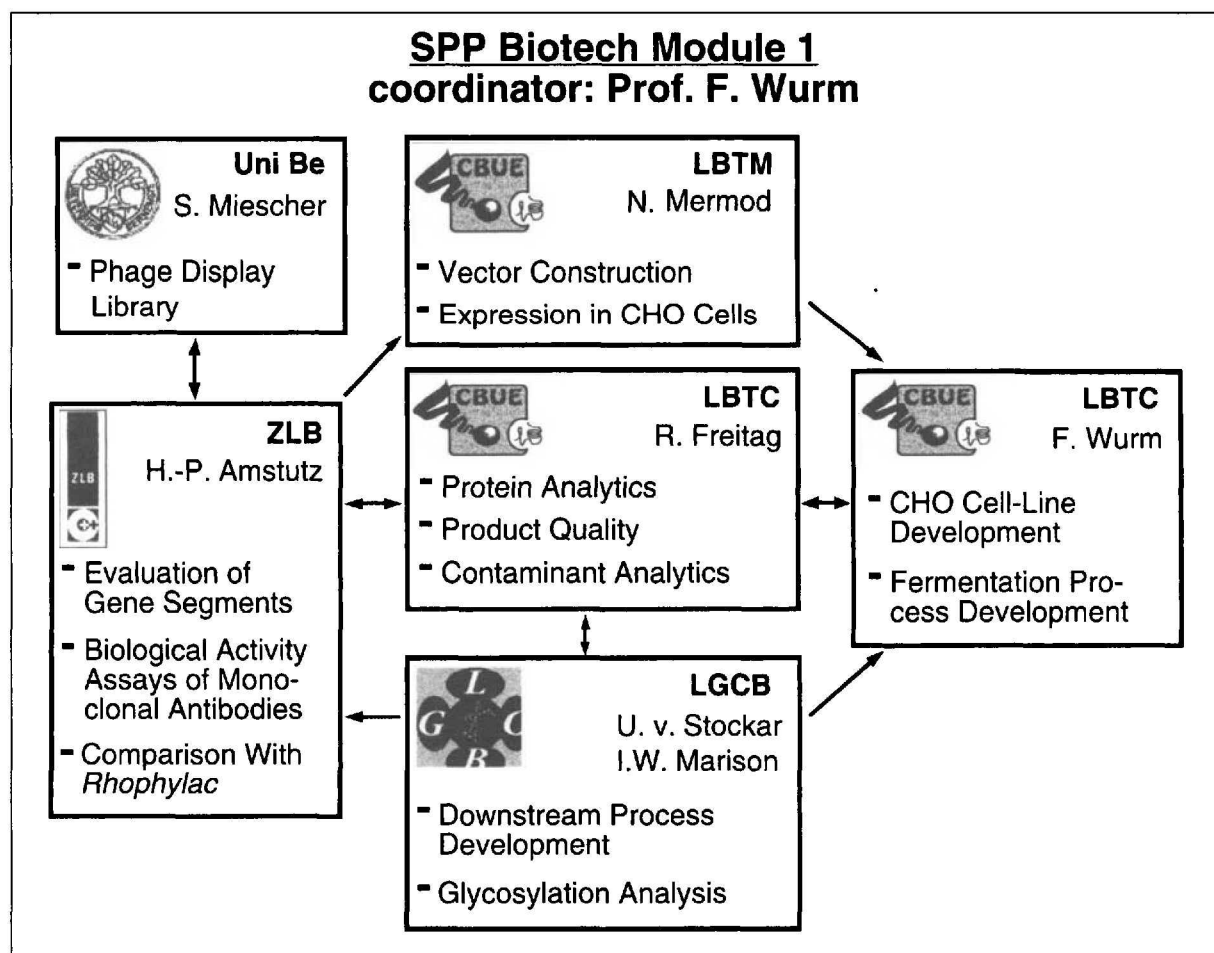


Fig. 1. Schematic representation of the different laboratories and their responsibilities in the *Rh* D project
