Prof. Dr. *Martin Quack*, Laboratory for Physical Chemistry, ETH Zürich is the new chairman (2011–2012) of the German Bunsen Society for Physical Chemistry.

HONORS

Novartis Early Career Award for Karl Gademann

Karl Gademann, professor for Organic Chemistry at the University Basel and member of the Editorial Board of CHIMIA has been awarded the 2010 Novartis Early Career Award in Organic Chemistry. The award includes an unrestricted grant to support his research. Gademann's research interests are at the interface of chemistry and biology, and focus on the total synthesis of natural products, their isolation from natural sources, and carrying out in vivo biological investigations.

Andreas Vitalis, postdoctorate fellow at the Biochemistry Institute of the University Zurich, received the Empiris-Award for Research in Brain Diseases.

Prof. Dr. *John Paul Maier*, Ordinarius for Physical Chemistry, University Basel, has been awarded a Humboldt-Research prize for his achievements in research on interstellar nebulae.

Edwin Constable, Department of Chemistry, University of Basel, receives a 'ERC Advanced Investigator Grant' of the European Research Council, endowed with 3.3 million Euro, for his research on sustainable technologies in the field of solar energy harvesting.

Patrick Maletinsky received for his dissertation in the field of quantum physics at the ETH Zürich the Prix A. F. Schläfli 2010 of the Swiss Academy of Sciences. The Prix A. F. Schläfli 2011 will be awarded to a young researcher (<35 years old) working in the field of chemistry. Deadline for proposals is March 31st, 2011.
